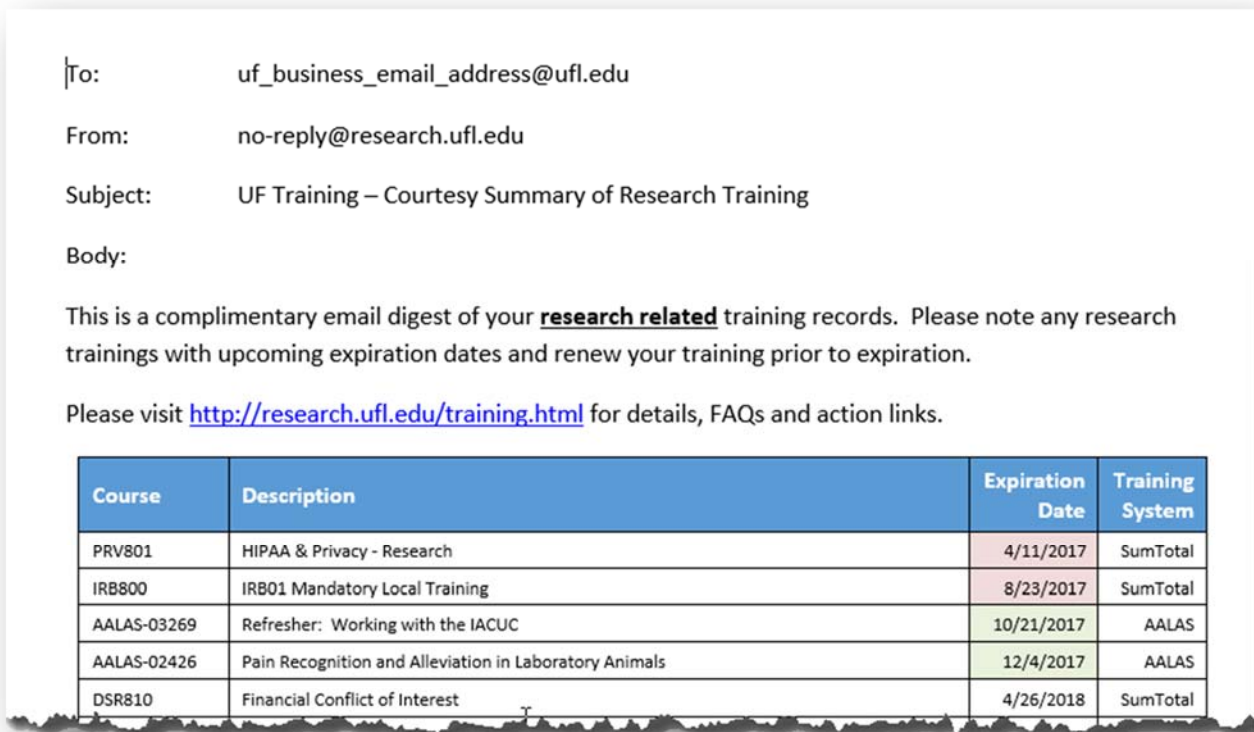


The Office of Research, Enterprise Systems, and Training & Organizational Development are pleased to announce a new service that our research community requested: courtesy transcripts of research related trainings.

In short: in mid-December anyone with active research training in our systems will receive an email that (a) lists research trainings and (b) when they expire. This is a courtesy transcript and there is nothing that recipients must do. These courtesy transcripts will be sent in the middle of every December and June starting in December 2017.

Here is a sample of what the email will look like:



This courtesy transcript was developed because many researchers expressed frustration related to renewing their research related training. Issues cited included:

1. Having to complete renewal trainings throughout the year: researchers asked if they could receive a list like this so they could complete all of their renewal trainings at once, rather than having to spread them out through the year as they expire.
2. Expiration notifications: some courses do not send out warnings before they expire. A transcript like this allows investigators to plan in advance if they are so inclined.
